## DIRECTIONS

NEW YORK CITY: North on I-87, I-287 and I-684 onto Rt.22 through Wingdale; east on Rt. 55 to Gaylordsville, CT; North on Rt. 7 to Kent; left on Rt. 341.

ALBANY: East on I-90 to Exit B3 (Rt. 22); south on Rt. 22 through Wingdale; east on Rt. 55 to Gaylordsville, CT; north on Rt. 7 to Kent; left on Rt. 341.

BOSTON: West on I-90 to Rt. 102, to Rt. 7 (Lee); south to Kent; right on Rt. 341.

HARTFORD: I-84 west to Exit 7 (Danbury); north on Rt. 7 to Kent; left on Rt. 341.
